Context

Occupational health and safety is not steered from a binder: it happens on the ground, in hazard identification and worker participation. Many organisations document a system perfectly while nobody at the workstation has ever heard of it.

- Hazard sources, including organisational and psychosocial ones
- Rating method and significance criteria
- Legal and other requirements: keeping them current

04. Operational control

- The hierarchy of controls, level by level
- Management of change and control of procurement
- Emergency preparedness and response

05. Monitoring, investigation and improvement

- Lagging indicators and leading indicators
- Investigation of incidents under clause 10.2
- Management review and continual improvement
